- 1. <u>PROGRAM NAME</u>: A Co-Creative Education Program of Humanities and Sciences to Solve Global Issues Confronting Japan and Latin America (La-CEP)
- 2. <u>PROJECT OVERVIEW</u>: This project is a collaborating initiative between Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (TUFS), Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology (TUAT), and the University of Electro-Communications (UEC) to jointly foster human resources with practical vision and an active role in the global community to solve global-level issues including environment, resources, energy, food, and socioeconomic development that affect Latin America and Japan. 5. <u>PERIOD OF STAY</u>

- 1) Short-term Program (summer visit): from the end of August to the end of September, 2018 (1 month)
- 2) Short-term Program (winter visit): from the end of November to the end of December, 2018 (1 month)

8. <u>EXPENDITURE FOR AIRPLANE TICKET</u>

Airplane ticket fee for a round trip between Brazil and Japan is supported through subsidies from MEXT (Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture Sports, Science and Technology), up to 180,000JPY.

9. <u>SCHOLARSHIP</u>

A scholarship of the amount of 80,000JPY per month is provided by JASSO (Japan Student Services Organization) for the applicants satisfy criteria.
